GAOC <u>Use of Tobacco Products and Nicotine Delivery Devices</u> GAOC (See JCDAA)

The use of tobacco products in any form and/or of any nicotine delivery

device is prohibited for staff members in any school building owned or

operated by the district; within 10 feet of entrances, open windows, and air

intake vents of such buildings; in other district facilities; and in school

vehicles. {Any use of tobacco products or nicotine delivery devices on district

property shall be only in areas designated for such purpose.

For the purposes of this policy, "nicotine delivery device" means any

device that can be used to deliver nicotine or nicotine salts to the person

inhaling from the device. Such definition shall include, but may not be limited

to, any electronic cigarette, cigar, cigarillo, pipe, or personal vaporizer.
