MAY 9, 2019

The Board of Education of Unified School District 248 met at the Board Office on Monday, May 9, 2019. President, Dale Shireman, called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Board members present were: Roger Breneman, Dave Goble, Lori Johnson, Peggy Marshall, Beth Murphy, Kelly Peak, and Dale Shireman. Also present were: Superintendent, Blaise Bauer; Clerk, Becky Mein; Treasurer, Laurie Masters; HS Principal, Todd Ferguson; Assistant HS Principal, Tom Stegman; MS Principal, BJ Pruitt; RVH Principal, Mark LaTurner; RVH Assistant Principal, Tina Daniel; WestRidge Executive Director, Dan Duling; GTA Representative, Melodee Knopp; and Cecily Perry, Hometown Girard.

Dave Goble moved, Beth Murphy seconded the motion for the approval of the agenda with addition of item 16F-Resignation; approval of the minutes of the April 8, 2019 board meeting, approval of the revised treasurer's report and the bills be approved for payment, amounting to \$534,783.58. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Roger Breneman moved, Lori Johnson seconded the motion to approve the following donations: \$550.00-Ann Paarmann-Technical Scholarships for GHS; \$500.00-National FCCLA (iBuckle/Up)-GHS FCCLA; \$300.00-Ryan Severt-GHS Track; and \$10,000.00 Jump Start Grant-RVH Summer Early Childhood Program, for the 2019-2020 fiscal year. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Dan Duling, WestRidge Executive Director, presented information on the various community service projects our students have been involved with their residents.

The USD 248 Long Range Strategic Plan was presented by the respective Building Administrator.

Dave Goble moved, Peggy Marshall seconded the motion to approve the MOU with Girard Medical Center for Nursing Services. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Beth Murphy moved, Lori Johnson seconded the motion to approve the 2019-2020 Middle School student handbook. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Peggy Marshall moved, Roger Breneman seconded the motion to approve the 2019-2020 School Board meeting dates, as presented. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Kelly Peak moved, Dave Goble seconded the motion to enter executive session at 7:05 pm for a period of 10 minutes, for the purpose of non-elected personnel exception under KOMA with the Board Members, Superintendent, and Assistant HS Principal, Tom Stegman present. This executive session was required to protect the privacy interests of an identifiable individual. Motion carried. 7 – 0. Tom Stegman was excused from the executive session at 7:10 pm.

Back to regular session at 7:15 pm

Kelly Peak moved, Dave Goble seconded the motion to enter executive session at 7:15 pm for a period of 10 minutes for the exception for employer-employee negotiations under KOMA, with the Board Members, and Superintendent present. This executive session was required for Meet and Confer items. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Back to regular session at 7:25 pm.

Kelly Peak moved, Peggy Marshall seconded the motion to accept the following resignations/Retirements: Nancy Boore-RVH Instructor; Steve Bever-GHS Head Baseball Coach; Jeremiah Hudson-GHS Assistant Baseball Coach; Dalton Steffens-GMS Custodian; Ron Trammell-RVH Custodian; and Tom Stegman-GHS Assistant HS Principal. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Dave Goble moved, Lori Johnson seconded the motion to approve the following employment recommendations: Lindsey Schiebe-RVH ESOL Para; Tara Bowin-Girard Medical Center/USD 248 School Nurse; Dana Crain-GHS Assistant Volleyball Coach; Tim Lloyd-GMS Custodian; Linda Scales-RVH Custodian; Annie Robinson, Diana Shadden and David Bennett-Summer Maintenance; Carson Severt-Summer Technology Office Aide; approved the certified personnel contract extensions for 2019-2020; and approved the classified contracts for 2019-2020. No action taken on RVH Elementary Instructor. Motion carried. 7 – 0.

Principal reports were distributed in the Board Packets.

Superintendent, Blaise Bauer, discussed the banking services. Consensus of the Board is to remain with our local GN Bank.

Beth Murphy presented her report from the Interlocal and Lori Johnson presented her report from Greenbush.
